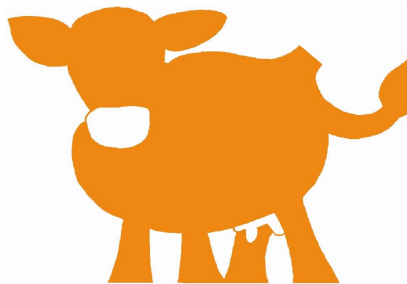

## Launch of Climate Friendly Food

**Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> October, 10.00am to 1.00pm**

Climate Friendly Food will officially launch the UK's most comprehensive carbon footprint calculator for farmers and growers, along with the world's first low carbon participatory certification scheme.

To celebrate the launch, Climate Friendly Food have organised a week-long series of events. Starting in Dartington, Mukti Mitchell and Jonathan Smith will cycle 130 miles to Bristol, stopping at organic farms on the way.

Climate Friendly Food is committed to minimising its carbon footprint, so we're using sustainable travel to promote low carbon food. We will also be eating climate friendly food as we attach great importance to putting principles in to practice.
